**Patna, Feb 3, 2010:** At last, organisers of Bihar Science Conference became successful. **His excellency former President of India and "Prakshepatra Ke Purodha" Dr. A.P.J Kalam**, has confirmed his participation as **"Keynote Speaker in the Inaugural Function"** of the **3<sup>rd</sup> Bihar Science Conference** being organized by BBrains Development Society commonly known as 'BiharBrains' on 11th February 2010. This conference is hosted by Magadh University, at Gaya College. Hon'ble CM Sri Nitish Kumar will inaugurate the conference. Briefing this news to media, **Bibhuti Bikramaditya**, chairman of the society said that Dr. Kalam's address to the scientific community will ignite efforts in creating conducive research and development environment in the state. We were trying to invite him since the first Bihar Science Conference which was held at Patna Science College in 2008.

**Prof. Shreekant Sharma, chairman of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bihar Science Conference** said that this is great moments for all of us. Gaya College and all residents of Gaya city is eagerly waiting for his arrival in the city for and his keynote address in the august gathering.

The Conference will be attended by more than 600 scientists of India and Abroad. Scientists from university of NASA, Max Planck research Institute, Germany, Korea and USA, IITs, NITs, IISC, Central universities and other research institutes of India. The eminent scientist who are going to deliver his keynote lecture are Prof. S.E.Hasnain (Member, SAC-PM), Dr. U.N.Singh (Chief Technologies, NASA Langley Research Center, NASA), Prof. Anil K. Gupta (Indian Institute of Management, Ahmadabad), Prof. A.K. Bhowmick (Indian Institute of Technology, Patna), Prof. H.C.Verma (IIT, Kanpur, Sri Ramesh Yadav (Cradle Technologies, USA), Dr. Jitendra Kumar (Vice President, IKP Knowledge Park, Hyderabad); Prof Sharma added.

This conference is on the pattern of Indian Science Congress in which one university gets "Hosting University status". Patna University is the first hosting university for this conference, He said.

**Prof. Arvind Kumar** Sinha convener of the conference informed that 27 technical lectures have been allotted in the subject wise technical sessions that includes 1 inaugural keynote lecture, 5 plenary lectures, 14 keynote lecture and 7 special lectures. Around 220 papers were selected for presentation in the conference. He said that theme of the conference is "Improvement of Research Quality towards Sustainable Development" and committee has decided to have one special session for the discussion on theme.

**Prof. Santosh Kumar, organizing secretary of the conference and joint secretary** of the society said that BBrains Development society commonly known as BiharBrains has given platform for all educated people of Bihar and will doing all its effort for bringing science and technology environment on track. Organizing Bihar Science Conference is one of the initiatives taken by the society.

**Prof. Dolly Sinha**, General Secretary of the society and Principal of Magadh Mahila College said that I am happy that this conference is gaining momentum and becoming show piece of Bihar. Time has come that scientists of Bihar should involve themselves in scientific research. This conference will be an excellent opportunity to report research outcome in the frontline areas of science and technology. She added.

The three day affair will have oral and poster presentation which covers all areas of Physical sciences, Chemical sciences, Biological sciences, Earth sciences, Electronics and Information Technology. There will be best oral presentation awards and best poster awards to be selected from each of the subject areas.
